


## Connecting hard drives to record archives to the Line NVR 2U Linux video server

Turn off your computer and connect a power and data cable to the HDD.



Turn on the computer and launch the Disks utility from the Settings folder on the desktop.




- 3 Select your hard drive from the menu on the left.



(The 120-250 GB disk is a system disk and is not recommended to be used for the archive)



- 4 If necessary, format the hard drive. Select **Ext4** as the file system.



- 5 Mount the disk for the system to recognize it.




- 6 **Disable** Automatic mount options and click OK.

To change the mount settings, enter the **root** password.

After restarting the server, the disk will be available /mnt/.....

7 You can mount the disk without rebooting the server.

**Points 5 and 6 must be performed to automatically mount the drive when the server starts.**



8 Connecting the disk for archive recording. Go to the folder /mnt/.....

> **Create a folder (for example, line8) and select it.**
